SEPTA to Provide free rides on Broad Street Line from Eagles Game against the Chargers on Nov. 7 sponsored by DraftKings

PHILADELPHIA (November 5, 2021) – Fans traveling from the Eagles/Chargers game from NRG Station this Sunday, Nov. 7 can ride home for free. The Free Rides program is aimed at offering a safe and convenient post-game travel option for fans and is sponsored this week by DraftKings.

Free rides from NRG Station will begin at 6 p.m. and end at 10 p.m. Kickoff at the Linc is 4:05 p.m. Please note: Regular fares will apply for all Broad Street Line travel to the game.

SEPTA will add service for the game. A total of 10 Sports Express trains will be added on the Broad Street Line to supplement regularly scheduled service. Sports Express service will run every 10 minutes from Fern Rock Station starting at 1:30 p.m. until 3:10 p.m.

The Broad Street Line provides convenient service to Eagles games and other big events for riders throughout the region. There is a free transfer to the Broad Street Line from the Market-Frankford Line and City Trolley routes at 15th Street/City Hall, and it is just a short walk from Regional Rail stations in Center City. It also connects to bus routes that provide service throughout the city and region, and it's easily accessible from the PATCO High Speed Line for riders from South Jersey.

To speed their trips to the game, SEPTA riders are encouraged to load funds on a SEPTA Key card before their travel or purchase a one-way Quick Trip ticket for travel to NRG Station. For more information about the SEPTA Key, visit www.septa.org/key.
